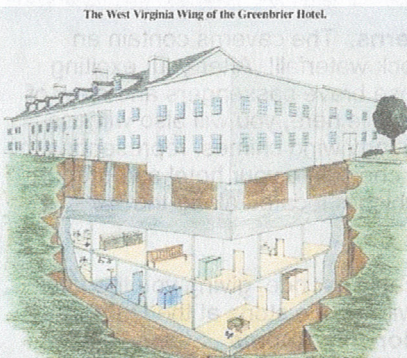

WEST VIRGINIA & PITTSBURGH

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1** - A morning departure from your departure point has you traveling to Huntington, WV to visit the **Heritage Farm Museum & Village**... home to over 15 log structures, including 5 log cabin inns, 7 award-winning museums, and an Artisan Center. The mission of Heritage Farm is to be a source of hope and renewal for the Appalachian Region. During your visit you will experience early pioneer life through exhibits and interactive folk crafts. You will also watch artisans at work using traditional methods. After your visit, you will check into your hotel and freshen up before enjoying **dinner** at an area restaurant.
- Day 2** - Following a continental breakfast, depart for the train station to **board Amtrak's Cardinal Train for a sightseeing excursion through New River Gorge** which will take you from Huntington to White Sulphur Springs passing abandoned coal towns, waterfalls, and white water rafters. Arrive in White Sulphur Springs to enjoy lunch on your own. *(Bus will be waiting for group in White Sulphur Springs.)* This afternoon you will meet your local guide for a **walking tour of Lewisburg** which will include a visit to the **North House Museum** where you will learn about the diverse history and culture of the Greenbrier Valley from the various exhibits. After your visit, enjoy free time shopping on your own in Lewisburg. Later, you will depart for your hotel to check-in and relax before departing for **dinner** in the area.
- Day 3** - Enjoy a continental breakfast, then check out and depart for the famous **Greenbrier Resort for a Bunker Tour**. Construction for the 112,544 square-foot bunker began in 1958, 720 feet into the hillside under the Greenbrier's West Virginia Wing. Once complete in 1961, the facility was maintained in a constant state of readiness by a small group of government employees working undercover. After the tour, enjoy lunch on your own and free time to explore the Resort. Depart for your next night's lodging in the Cass area. **Dinner** will be at the hotel this evening.
- Day 4** - Enjoy breakfast, then depart for a fun-filled day of "riding the rails" through the beautiful countryside. Climb a board the **Greenbrier Express** which follows the clear, free-flowing Greenbrier River to the small mountain village of Durbin. Sightings of deer, river otters, and black bear along with a wide variety of eagles, hawks, ospreys, and other aquatic birds are common. A "King of the Road" **hobo lunch** will be provided. At the conclusion of the train tour, your group will enjoy a chance to stop at the Rail & Trail Store before departing for **dinner and an evening of entertainment**.
- Day 5** - Following breakfast, check out and depart for a visit to the **Smoke Hole Caverns**. The caverns contain an abundance of flowing stone, gleaming creamy white stone that looks like a rock waterfall! After your exciting visit, depart a visit the **Flight 93 Memorial**. The memorial is dedicated to those brave passengers and crew of United Flight 93 who gave their lives on that fateful day of September 11th. While here, you will also witness **The Tower of Voices**, a monumental, 93 feet tall musical instrument holding forty wind chimes, representing the forty passengers and crew members. From here, continue to **Pittsburgh** to check into your hotel and prepare for **dinner in the restored P & LE Train Station** at the Grand Concourse, which is located along the Monongahela River.
- Day 6** - After breakfast at the hotel, depart for the **Duquesne Incline** for a fabulous cable car ride, giving you the best views of Pittsburgh. Later, meet your guide for a **tour of Pittsburgh**, which will include stops at the **University of Pittsburgh's Cathedral of Learning** where you will tour some of the **Nationality Rooms**. Stained glass, carved stone and inlaid wood reflect the cultures, which Pittsburgh immigrants brought from Europe, Asia, Africa, and the Middle East. You will also visit the **Heinz Memorial Chapel** for a tour of this historic landmark with its remarkable stained glass windows. After lunch on your own in the area, depart for a tour of the **Phipps Conservatory & Botanical Gardens**. This beautiful 13-room Victorian glasshouse and gardens features tropical plants, palms, orchids, ferns, desert plants and bonsai as well as many special exhibits. Return to your hotel to freshen up before departing for **dinner** this evening.
- Day 7** - Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then check out and depart for a visit to **Frank Lloyd Wright's architectural creation, "Fallingwater."** Considered one of Wright's most widely acclaimed works, it best exemplifies his philosophy of organic architecture as the harmonious union of art and nature. Enjoy lunch on your own in the area before departing for home with fond memories of **West Virginia & Pittsburgh**.
